What is it?

With a PRL library card, you now have access to OverDrive eBooks and eAudiobooks from TRAC.

Restrictions?

TRAC & PRL Checkout limit: 10 titles at a time.

Preference is given to whoever has the home library card for that system. Holds placed within the PRL OverDrive will be given preference to PRL members and vice versa.

Certain collections, including simultaneous use items like magazines, may not be lent outside of the home network due to agreements with publishers.

If you recommend a title, it is recommending that Parkland purchase the item.

Wait List Items

Items that are not currently available will come up as a wait list item on the Overdrive website (they will not be visible on Libby).

These items are not available to request.

The button to "place a hold" will bring up a form to enter your email for notification but is not functioning.
